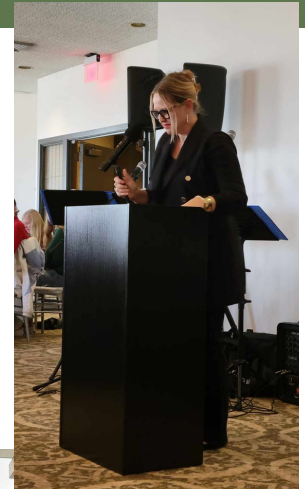
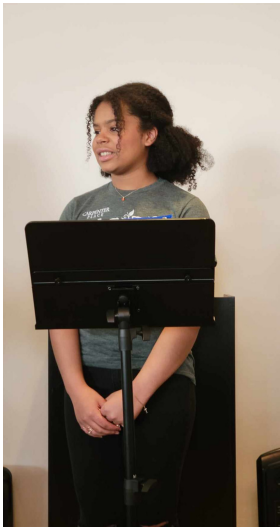


# DAUGHTERS OF THE KING

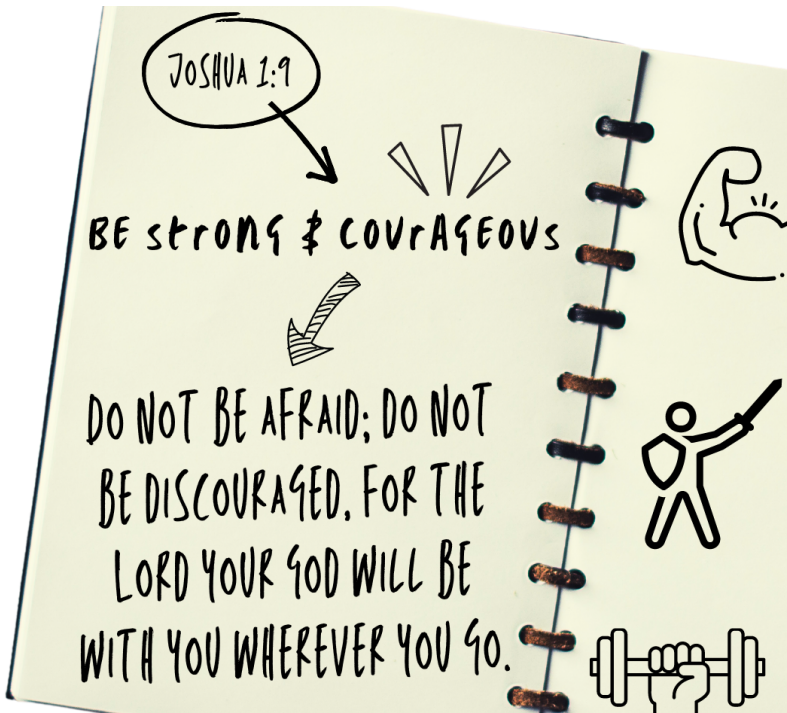
